74AUP1G11 Low-power 3-input AND gate

### 1. General description

The 74AUP1G11 is a single 3-input AND gate. Schmitt-trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant of slower input rise and fall times. This device ensures very low static and dynamic power consumption across the entire V<sub>CC</sub> range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V. This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using I<sub>OFF</sub>. The I<sub>OFF</sub> circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

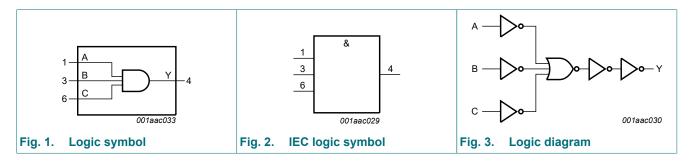

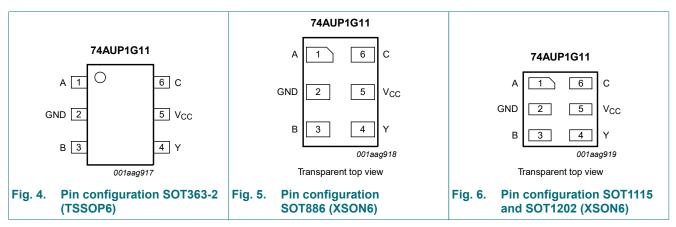

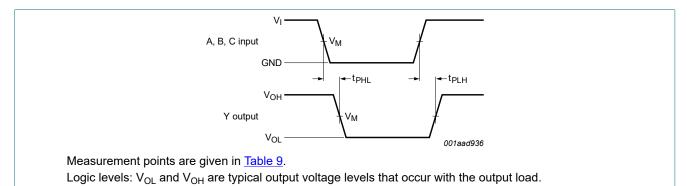

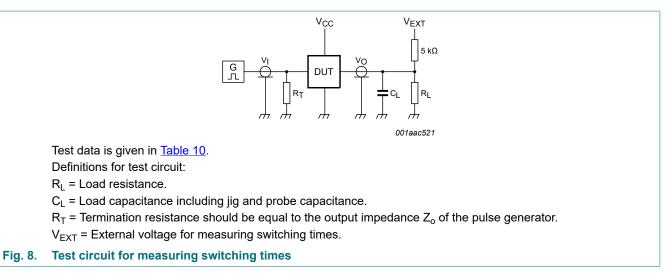


#### Fig. 7. Input A, B and C to output Y propagation delay times

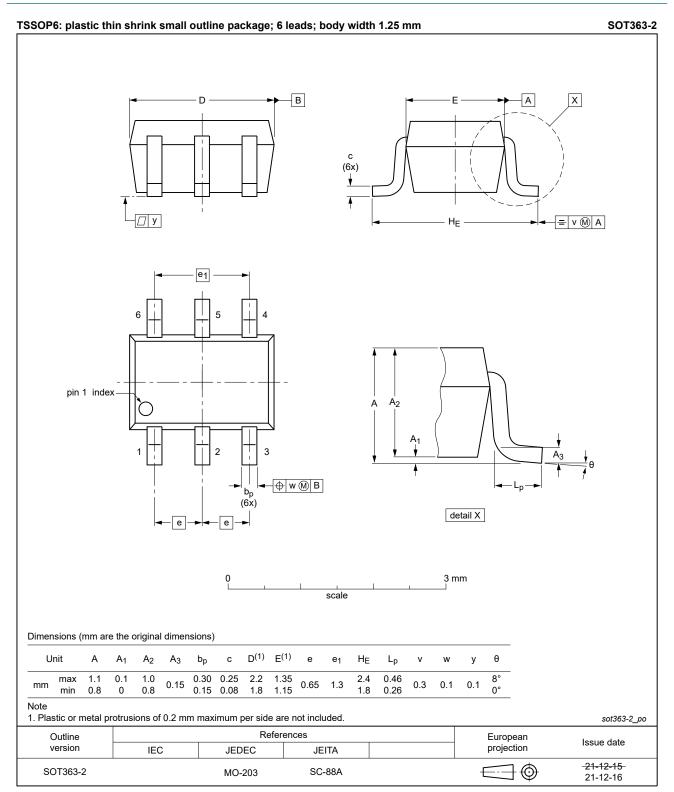

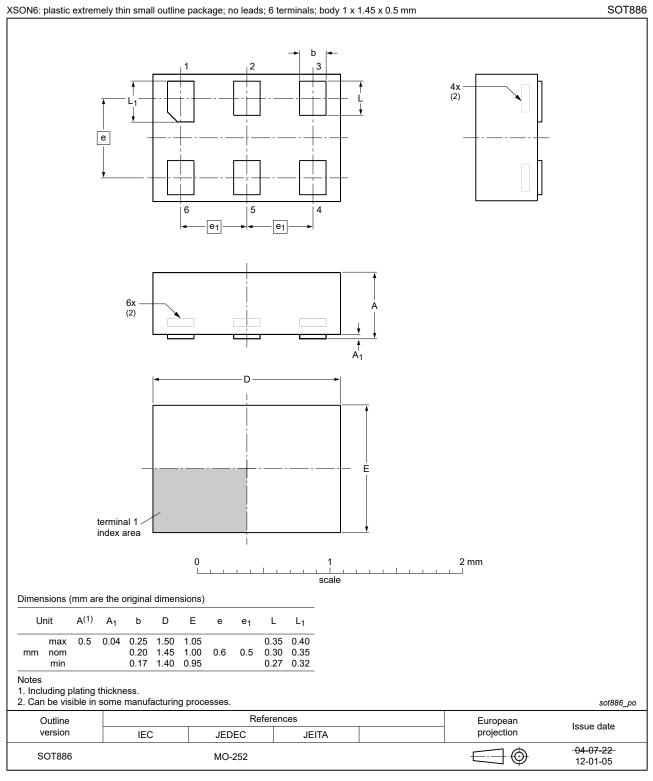
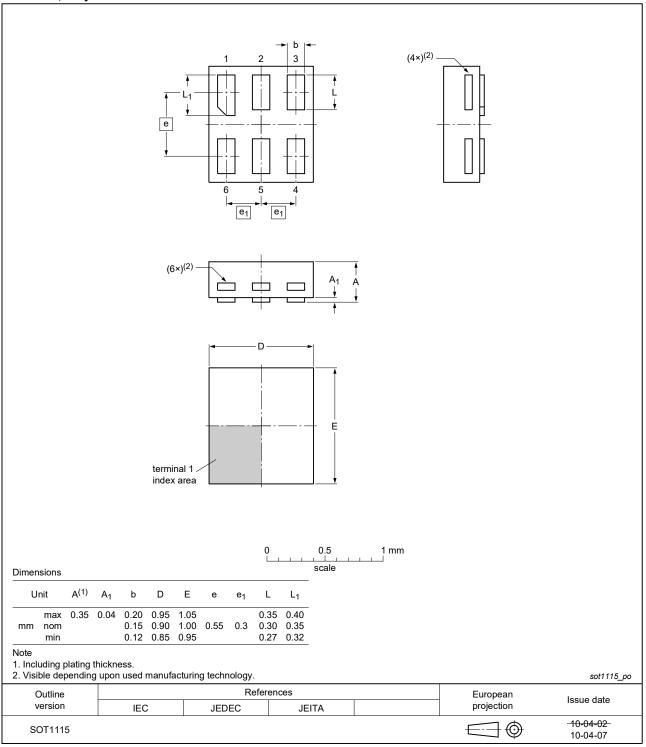


Fig. 10. Package outline SOT886 (XSON6)

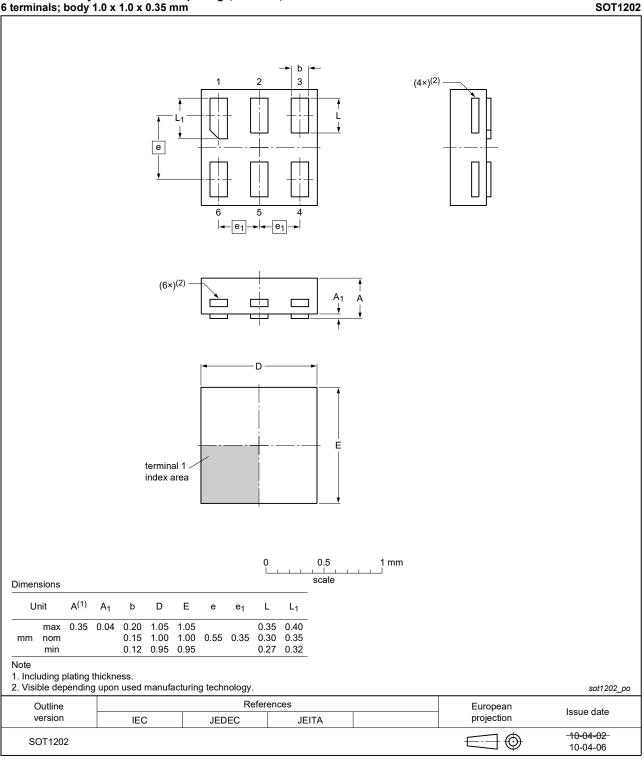
