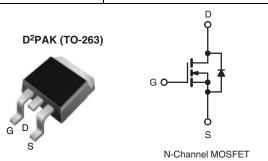

The D<sup>2</sup>PAK (TO-263) is a surface mount power package capable of accommodating die sizes up to HEX-4. It provides the highest power capability and the lowest possible on-resistance in any existing surface mount package. The D<sup>2</sup>PAK (TO-263) is suitable for high current applications because of its low internal connection resistance and can dissipate up to 2.0 W in a typical surface mount application.

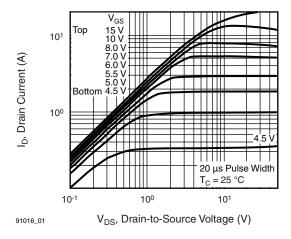


Fig. 1 - Typical Output Characteristics,  $T_C = 25$  °C

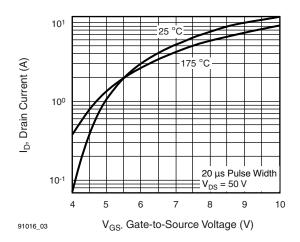


Fig. 3 - Typical Transfer Characteristics

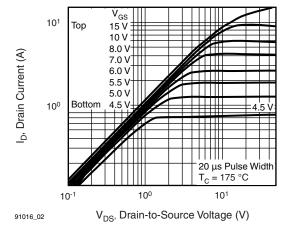


Fig. 2 - Typical Output Characteristics,  $T_C = 175$  °C

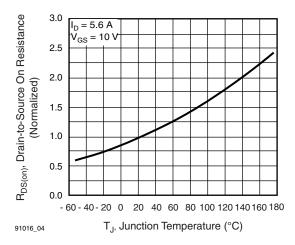
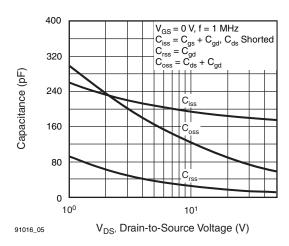


Fig. 4 - Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature

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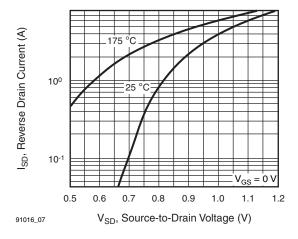
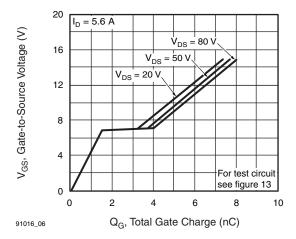


Fig. 5 - Typical Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

Fig. 8 - Maximum Safe Operating Area





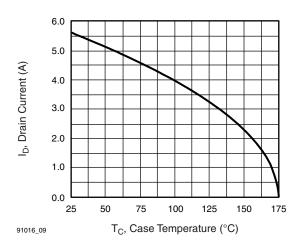


Fig. 9 - Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature

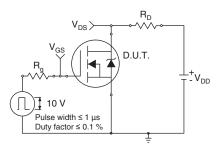


Fig. 10a - Switching Time Test Circuit

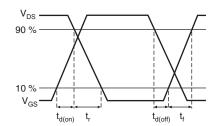


Fig. 10b - Switching Time Waveforms

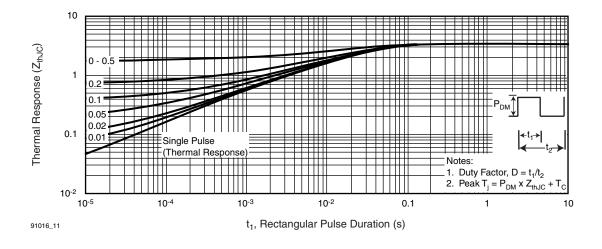
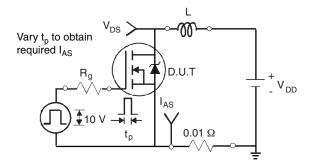
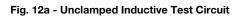


Fig. 11 - Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case

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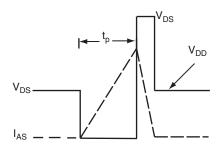


Fig. 12b - Unclamped Inductive Waveforms

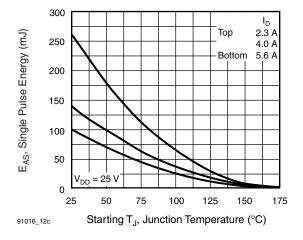


Fig. 12c - Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Drain Current

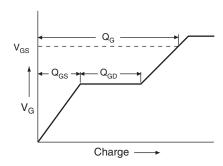


Fig. 13a - Basic Gate Charge Waveform

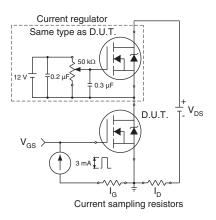
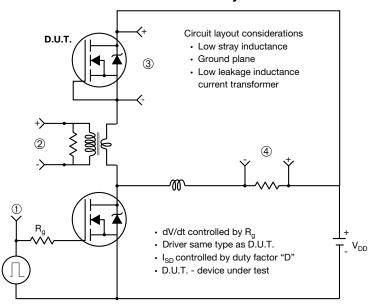


Fig. 13b - Gate Charge Test Circuit



#### Peak Diode Recovery dV/dt Test Circuit



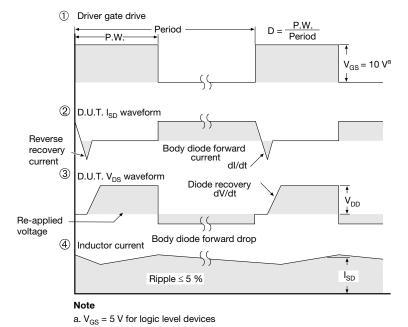


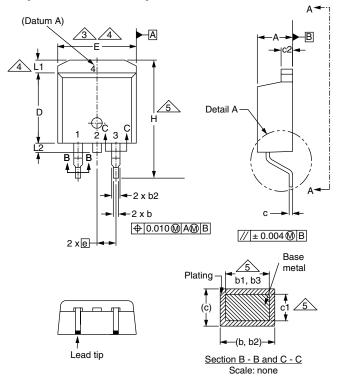
Fig. 14 - For N-Channel

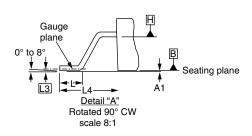

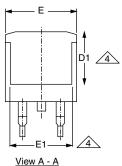
